

Governance and Nominations Committee: Remit and Membership

Remit

- (a) To ensure that the University complies with all relevant governance frameworks, including the Scottish Code of Good HE Governance, and to bring forward recommendations for change where necessary.
- (b) To oversee regular reviews of the effectiveness of Court and Senate and their committees.
- (c) To review periodically Court's current standing orders to ensure that they continue to support its work effectively.
- (d) To review periodically the arrangements for the induction of new Court members to ensure that they best prepare those members for their role.
- (e) To consider, and bring forward, recommendations in relation to other current issues relating to best practice in institutional governance that it considers relevant to Court's current and future effectiveness.
- (f) To make recommendations to the Court Appointing Committee in respect of the appointment of core and co-opted lay members of Court as set out in articles 6(1)(a) and 7(1) of the University of Abertay Dundee (Scotland) Order of Council 1994.
- (g) To review and monitor the membership needs of Court and its standing committees and to solicit, receive and review details of potential members.

Ex officio

Chair of Court (1)
Principal & Vice-Chancellor (1)
President of the Students' Association (1)

Quorum

Three members, of whom at least two shall be lay members of Court
